## Colorado native Mark Hubbard commits to inaugural Colorado Web.com Tour event Mark Hubbard to play in TPC Colorado Championship at Heron Lakes

BERTHOUD, Colorado – Colorado touring golf professional, Mark Hubbard, will be one of the headliners in the July 8-14 TPC Colorado Championship at Heron Lakes, part of the Web.com Tour, Path to the PGA TOUR.

"I cannot wait to play in the TPC Colorado Championship at Heron Lakes. I've missed playing golf in Colorado and I am so grateful for the opportunity to compete in my home state in front of friends and family," said Hubbard.

Originally from Denver, Colorado, Hubbard knows the Colorado golf scene well. He attended Colorado Academy in Denver where he was all-state in golf and basketball. Hubbard played collegiately at San Jose State University before turning professional in 2012.

He rose through the ranks of professional golf, graduating from the Mackenzie Tour – PGA TOUR Canada in 2013 to the Web.com Tour. In 2014, Hubbard earned six top-10s in his rookie year on the Web.com Tour, enough to finish inside The Top 25 and earn his PGA TOUR card. Hubbard competed on the PGA TOUR from 2015-17, earning nine top-10s during that stretch. He returned to the Web.com Tour in 2018 and this year is projected to regain his PGA TOUR card. He earned his first Web.com Tour win this year in February at the LECOM SunCoast Classic and has added four more top-25s through the first half of the season.

The TPC Colorado Championship at Heron Lakes will be the first annual PGA TOUR golf event in the state since The International at Castle Pines had its 20-year run end in 2006.

More than 500 volunteers have signed up to work the event at TPC Colorado which will play nearly 8,000 yards long.
